STUDENTS WHO DO NOT EARN THE MINIMUM GRADE MAY RETAKE THE INTRO WORKSHOP. STUDENTS NEED A MINIMUM GRADE OF C IN ALL OTHER COURSES THAT COUNT TOWARD THE MAJOR. GENRES: FICTION, LITERARY NONFICTION, POETRY, AND PLAYWRITING (AS A SECONDARY GENRE ONLY). STUDENTS INTERESTED IN JOURNALISM SHOULD CONSULT THE WORKSHEET FOR JOURNALISM & DESIGN. STUDENTS CONSIDERING TRANSLATION AS A SECONDARY GENRE SHOULD CONSULT WITH THE CHAIR. WORK IN PRIMARY GENRE MUST BEGIN BEFORE THE JUNIOR YEAR.
